Prior to the establishment of the Serbian Business Registers Agency (SBRA), the process of registering a business was done in trade courts, exclusively in paper form and without the ability to analyze any of the registered data. SBRA embarked on a project to develop a comprehensive information system, which would support the organization's core business functions and result in increased efficiency and availability of data. SBRA engaged Comtrade SI and worked closely with our team to develop a solution that's customized to the specific needs of the organization and in line with the EU's guidelines for registration procedures.

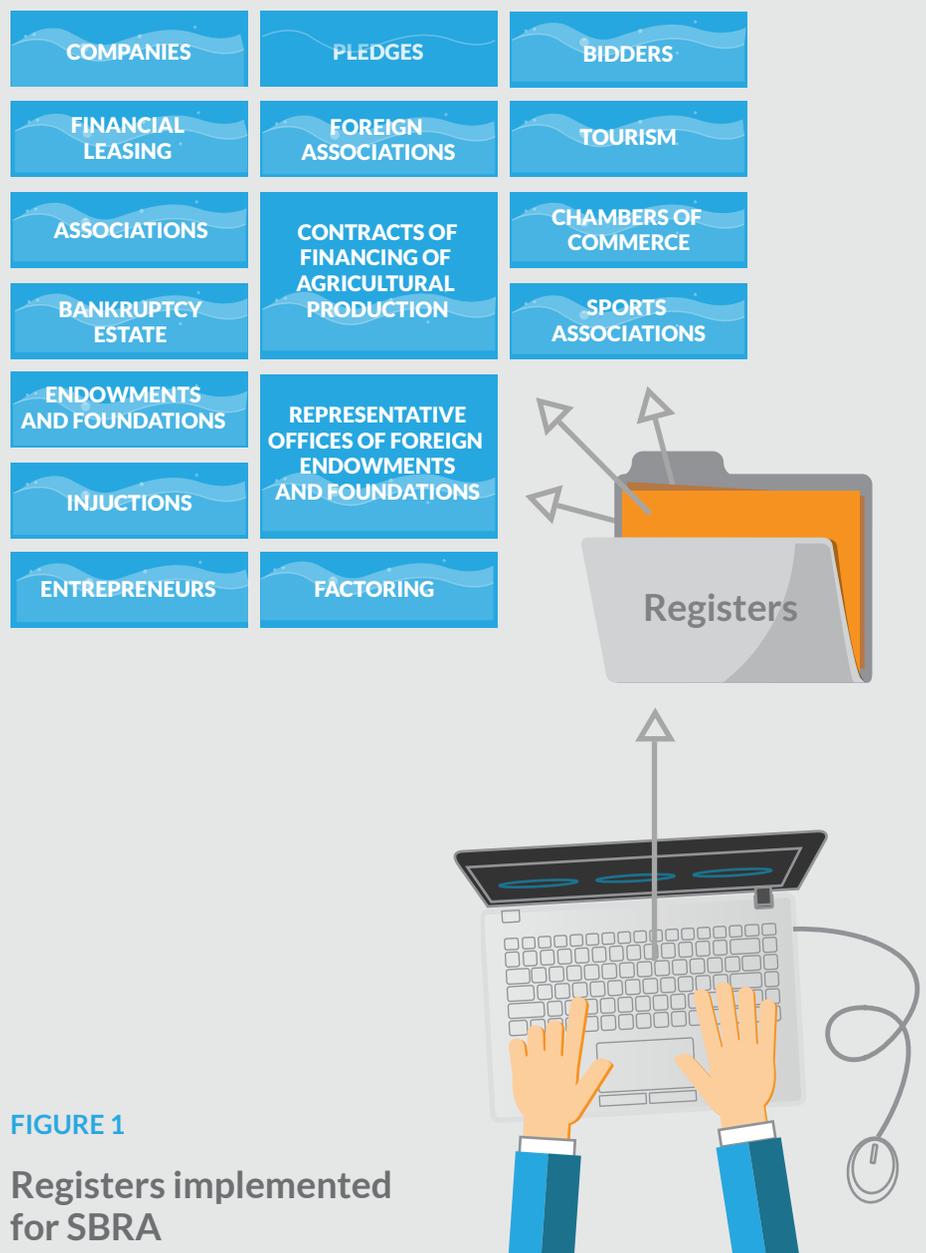

## OUR SOLUTION

- **Step 2:** Analysis and modelling of business processes

To fulfill technical requirements and business needs of SBRA, Comtrade SI used the latest technologies and project methodologies.

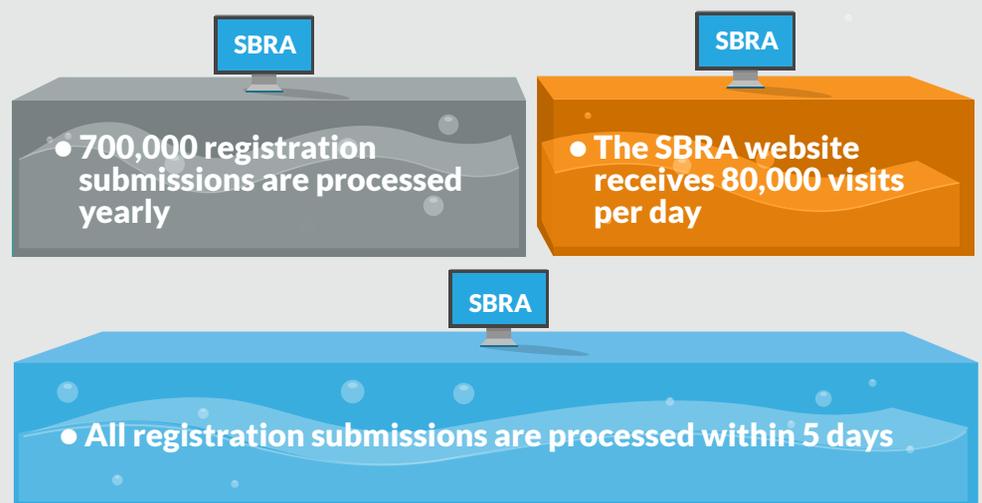

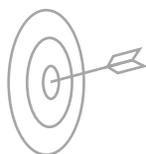

## RESULTS DELIVERED



The information system supports SBRA's core functionalities and procedures, providing a wide variety of Government to Government (G2G), Government to Business (G2B) and Government to Customer (G2C) services.

After a successful implementation of the information system, around 3 million registration submissions were processed, resulting in more than 400,000 registered entities, along with historical data and an electronic archive of more than 5 million documents. All registered data is now available on SBRA's website 24/7. The site receives about 80,000 visits per day.

The new system had a significant impact on efficiency as it helped reduce the time it takes to process registrations. Now all submissions are processed in 5 business days or less with more than 700,000 submissions processed yearly. The information system also enabled easier and faster exchange of information with relevant government institutions, including the Health Fund, Pension Fund, Central Registrar, Tax Administration, National Bank of Serbia and Ministry of Interior.

The creation of a one-stop-shop system helped to accelerate the procedure for establishing legal entities by linking all relevant government institutions (SBRA, Tax Administration, Health Fund and Pension Fund). As a result of the improved efficiency, Serbia received a high ranking by the World Bank, ultimately improving the country's standing on the World Bank's Doing Business list.
